



Family Math Engagement Grab & Go: Writing and Representing Numbers

This activity would be best used by:

Materials:

- paper and pencil or crayon

Steps:

1. Name any number to 10.
2. Ask the child to write the number.
3. Ask the child to draw a picture to represent the number.

Example:

Write the number seven.	Draw a picture of seven things.

Lagniappe:

- Practice with numbers up to 20. Extend to bigger numbers when the child is ready.
- Children may begin to represent bigger numbers using bundles of 10. In the example below, each vertical bar represents 10 ones.

Write the number twenty-seven.	Draw a picture of twenty-seven things.
