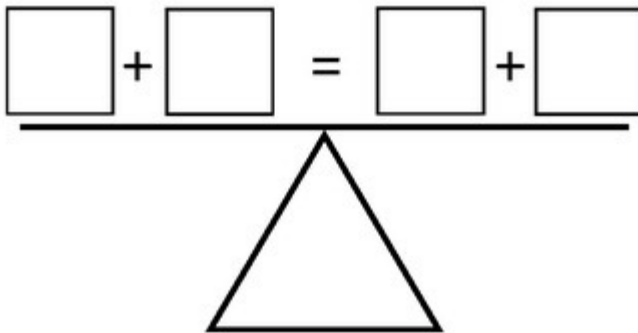

Materials:

Steps:

1. Talk to your child about the meaning of an equation- both sides are equal.
2. Fill in the boxes below with different numbers that could balance the scale, showing both sides are equal. For Example: $2 + 3 = 4 + 1$



Lagniappe:

- Jose combines his 15 marbles with Lucinda's marbles(m); together they have 121 marbles. Write an equation to determine how many marbles Lucinda has. (Possible Answers: $15 + m = 121$, $121 - m = 15$)
