Minutes

The Louisiana Student Standards Review Committee met on August 19, 2015, in the Riverview Ballroom A, located in the Hilton Capitol Center in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. The meeting was called to order at 9:15 a.m. by Dr. Regina Sanford, Chair. Dr. Sanford provided an overview of the standards review purpose and process as set forth by law and by the State Board of Elementary and Item II Secondary Education (BESE), and offered a description of the current Louisiana standards in English language arts and mathematics.

Dr. Sanford provided Committee members with copies of a letter dated August 17, 2015, from Senator Francis C. Thompson regarding the Item III longstanding work of the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) in Louisiana. She provided comments regarding the SREB and introduced Dr. Gene Bottoms, Senior Vice-President of SREB, who offered remarks.

Dr. Burns committed to seek input from universities pertaining to recommended changes to the content standards and to bring back that input to both the Committee and Subcommittees.

Dr. Sanford stated that the Committee is to make data driven decisions and, to aide in that process, requested that the Louisiana Department of Education provide members of the Committee and Subcommittees the raw cut scores, comparison data to previous tests, and the results of spring testing.

Dr. Sanford also requested that a definitive closure date be established for the Public Comment Portal.

Dr. Sanford reviewed next steps to be taken by the Committee and Subcommittees.

With no further business to come before the Louisiana Student Standards Review Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 12:29 p.m.
