



The State of Louisiana recognizes that hosting International Associate Teachers (IAT) is a collaborative effort between international government partners, Louisiana state-level representatives, host school systems and host schools. This guidance should be used to aid administrators and human resources in evaluating International Associate Teacher effectiveness per Louisiana Bulletin 130 and in line with national immigration guidelines.

All IATs acknowledge that the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) is required to monitor his/her progress and welfare. Each teacher gives permission pursuant to La. RS 17:1237 to the LDOE World Languages Specialists to receive personnel file information in their role as monitor and advocate of the teacher's professional activities and to release any of the teacher's measures of effectiveness for the use in annual IAT reports.

IATs shall be observed at least twice during the school year by school administration using an observation tool that aligns with the Louisiana Components of Effective Teaching. To ensure a positive exchange experience, IATs should receive on-going positive feedback from school and district leaders.

**Evaluators:** School principals or assistant principals shall evaluate IATs. Other designees, such as mentor teachers and/or LEA World Language Supervisors may conduct observations or assist with interpretations and translations to help inform the evaluator assessment of teacher performance.

**Intensive Assistance:** The evaluator shall submit a Louisiana IAT Incident Report for any IAT that needs an intensive assistance plan and collaborate with at least one statewide representative in developing the plan.

**Grievance Procedures:** In addition to the LEAs established grievance procedures, IATs have the right to air grievances to their sponsors (LDOE or CODOFIL), their home country representatives and to the US Department of State at <a href="mailto:Teacher\_Physician@state.gov">Teacher\_Physician@state.gov</a>. The IAT shall be entitled to support during the grievance procedure.
