INTRODUCTION & DATA SOURCE

This report is intended to produce a numerical picture of Special Education in Louisiana. It contains statistics about students with exceptionalities, their programs, and other student-level data. It is designed as a reference book to assist in planning and evaluating educational efforts for students with exceptionalities in Louisiana. The data reflect public school students only (unless otherwise noted) and include counts and/or percentages where meaningful.

The data are based on information submitted to the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) by school systems. Special education data are from Special Education Reporting (SER); regular education, discipline, and nonpublic enrollment data are from EdLink 360.

The education data include all public school students in Louisiana as of February 1, 2022. Special Education data are based on the February 1, 2022 Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) Special Education Student Membership Count; the October 1, 2021 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Child Count; federal reports; and ad hoc reports generated from SER. Footnotes for tables will indicate the source used.

Special appreciation is extended to all school systems and educational agencies that provided the information compiled in this publication.

STATISTICAL SUPPRESSION

The LDOE has modified and/or suppressed data reported to protect the privacy of students in compliance with the FERPA codified at 20 U.S.C. 123g. Because of the privacy protections, numerical and percentage totals may not add precisely to the sum of the row or column to which the total refers.

The strategies used to protect privacy vary and may include rounding or other techniques but do not substantially affect the general usefulness of the data. Rounding techniques are used with both counts and percentages. For example, actual numbers have been rounded down to the nearest multiple of 10 (e.g., the number 20 indicates there are between 20 and 29 students). For percents \geq indicates the actual percent is within 10 percentage points (e.g., $\geq 20\%$ indicates the percent is between 20.0% and 29.9%). Lastly, \sim indicates statistically unreliable information (e.g., Less than 10 students in a subgroup or subgroup not defined at that time).
