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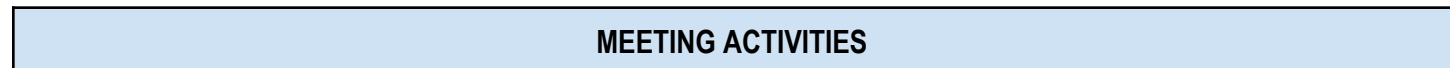
<b>OUTCOME</b>	By the end of this meeting, district leaders will be able to articulate their role in supporting school leaders (PSR) in moving all students towards proficiency (on or above grade level) in literacy. As measured by each department head updating their action plan located in our District ILT Shared Folder which includes who is responsible and updating with follow-up/impact of evidence. Immediate supervisors will give specific feedback on their respective departments' action plans.

<p><b>APPLY NEW LEARNING: What will ILT members be doing in schools?</b></p>	<p>Each ILT member will contribute to their departments' action plan and the department leader will upload it by February 10, 2023 (placed in the shared <a href="#">District ILT Folder</a>) to support our school leaders in moving students toward proficiency in literacy as aligned to the district's strategic plan and district goals.</p>
