2025 School and District Performance Scores

- Scores represent the 2024-2025 school year
- Final official scores using prior accountability system and 150-point scale
- Also releasing simulated scores using [new system and 100-point scale](#)
 - Simulations are not official results
 - Provided only to support school and system planning
 - First official scores under new system will be released in 2026 and measure 2025-2026 school year



2025 School and District Performance Scores

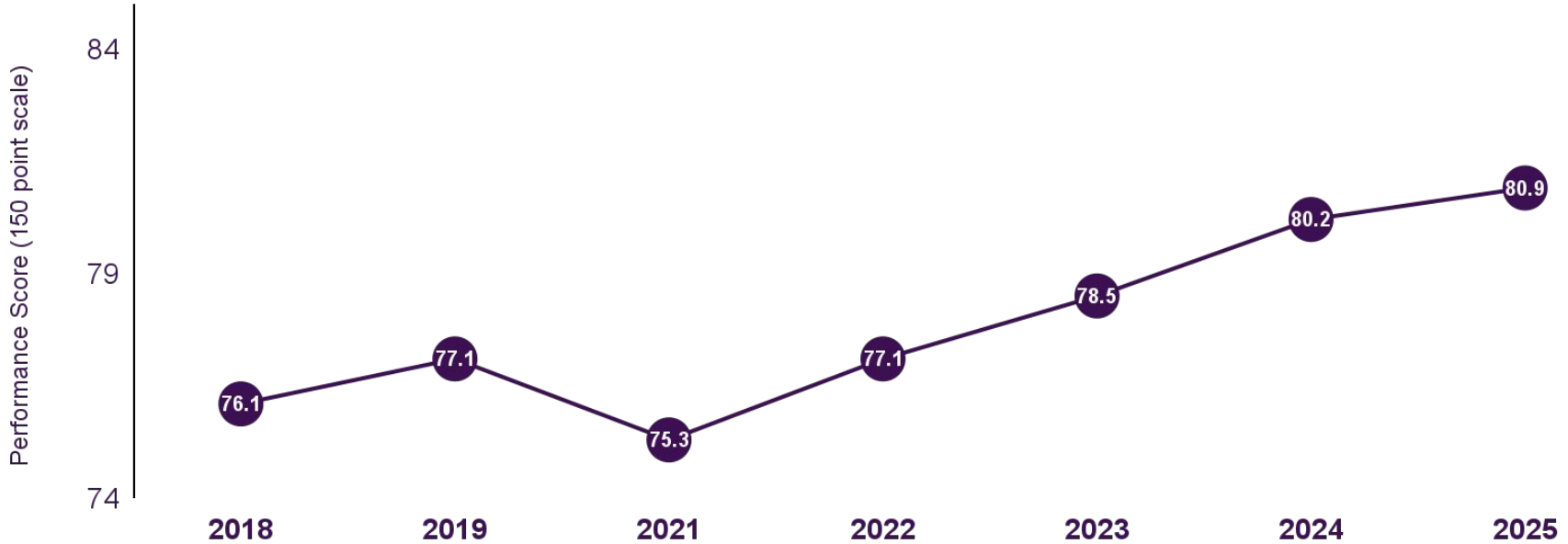
Louisiana's 2025 statewide performance score is 80.9, **up 5+ points since 2021 (75.3) and nearly a full point above last year (80.2).**

- Statewide results held or increased across all index areas
- Schools by letter grade:
 - A: 21%
 - B: 31%
 - C: 32%
 - D: 12%
 - F: 4%
 - Elementary and middle schools: 44% earned A or B
 - High schools: 70% earned A or B.

State Performance Score Since 2019



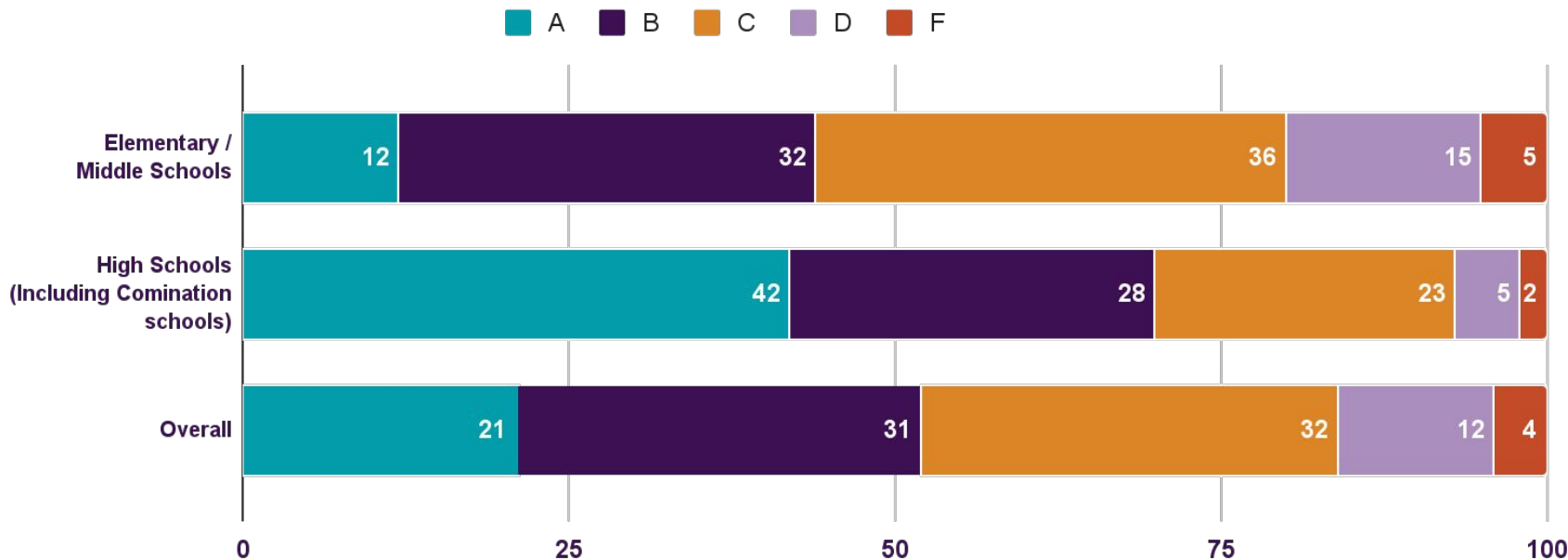
Louisiana reached an 80.9, its highest score since the inception of the current accountability system.

533 Top Gains Honorees

Top Gains Honorees are schools that:

- Earned a progress index equivalent to an 'A'; and
- Did not earn any Urgent Intervention Required labels for student groups



204 Opportunity Honorees

Opportunity Honorees are schools that are:

- In the top 10% for performance among Students with Disability, English Learners, or Economically Disadvantaged students; and
- Are not in Intervention Required status

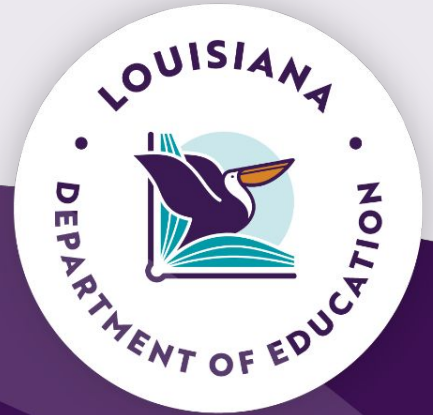

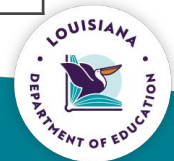

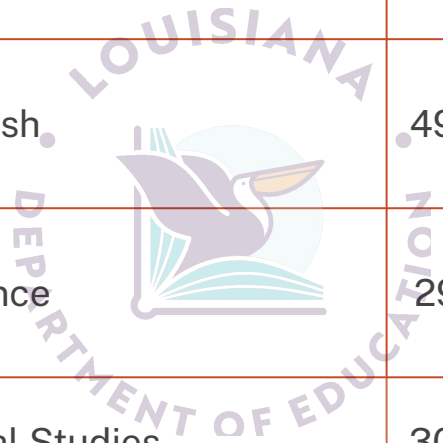

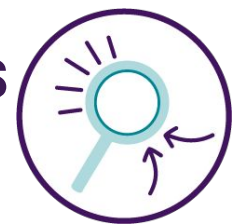
