Minutes

The Computer Science Education Commission met on Thursday, October 27, 2022, in the Iowa Room, located in the Claiborne Building in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. - 4 On motion of Ms. Sterling, seconded by Dr. Hunter Reed, the Computer Science Education Advisory Commission recommends that the LDOE utilize the National K-12 Computer Science Framework as a model for development of the Louisiana Computer Science Education Framework.
