Introduction

Students in grades 3 through high school may take practice tests in English language arts, mathematics, and science to help prepare them for the LEAP Connect statewide tests. The practice tests allow students and test administrators to do the following:

- practice using the online tools for computer-based tests and interacting with the secure testing platform
- respond to some of the types of questions they may find on the LEAP Connect test
- practice using the Directions for Practice Test Administration (test administrators) and the reference materials

Practice Test Guidance

Online Administration

The <u>DRC INSIGHT Portal</u> *User Guide* provides directions on how to prepare for the online administration of the practice tests. The following tasks need to be completed in DRC INSIGHT prior to administering the practice tests:

- Transfer and add students
- Assign and view accommodations
- Create test sessions
- Generate and print test tickets
- Review resources in DRC INSIGHT
- Review the Directions for Practice Test Administration (DPTA) and prepare reference materials

Scoring

General Scoring Information

The online practice tests are scored using a combination of automated and teacher scoring. Selected-response items (e.g., multiple choice) are automatically scored by the online system; however, responses to constructed-response items are scored by teachers. The DRC INSIGHT Portal *User Guide* explains how teachers access and use the *Educator Scoring* application in DRC INSIGHT to score student responses. Prior to using the *Educator Scoring* application, teachers should retrieve the scoring rubrics from the answer key documents, found on the Practice Test webpage or DRC INSIGHT under *Documents* in the *General Information* tab. The grade-level and content area answer keys are available in DRC INSIGHT and on the Practice Test webpage. The answer keys include answers to all item types, alignment information, and rubrics.

Reporting

Reports will generate in the DRC INSIGHT portal within 24 hours of the completion of at least one test session. DTCs or STCs wishing to issue reports without completing all sessions must log-in to the DRC INSIGHT Portal and select the "End Incomplete Test Session" button inside of the test session tab before printing. This allows teachers and schools to use reports to support the instructional use of practice tests. Only one test session within a practice test needs to be completed for reports to generate. Additionally, educator scoring does not need to be completed for reports to generate. Reports will refresh nightly after the initial posting to reflect any changes in test session completion and/or educator scoring. The *Report Delivery* menu of the DRC INSIGHT Portal *User Guide* explains how to access the online practice test reports in DRC INSIGHT and gives an explanation of the reports provided. There are no student or test session summary reports for practice tests. The following reports are available for practice test assessments:

- Student Response Map
