Interpretation Guidance

The purpose of the service accelerator is to recognize students who have committed to serving our country and have a binding agreement with a branch of the United States military.

As such, the following are not acceptable on their own:

- ASVAB score reports
- MEPS physical clearance
- Recruiter business cards
- JROTC / CAP participation
- Verbal statements or unsigned notes
- “Intent to enlist” without formal action

Service Academy Acceptance Letters

Acceptance to a military service academy is one form of documentation for service readiness. Service academy acceptance letters will be accepted in data certification from the following academies:

- United States Air Force Academy
- United States Coast Guard Academy
- United States Merchant Marine Academy
- United States Military Academy
- United States Naval Academy

Please note, nomination does not meet the requirement; full acceptance is the requirement.

Military Commitment Form

Military enlistment is the second form of documentation for service readiness. To demonstrate commitment to military enlistment, districts must provide a completed [DD Form 4](#) during data certification.

Please note, this documentation shows formal commitment, not intent or interest. Forms must be official, verifiable, and complete. Incomplete documentation may delay or invalidate certification. If there are extenuating circumstances, please email accountability@la.gov to be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
