### School Health Service Provider of the Year



# **Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year**



## **School Physical Activity**

The Louisiana Department of Education recognizes that healthy and physically active students tend to have better grades, school attendance, cognitive performance, and classroom behaviors. Additionally, schools play a vital role in allowing students the opportunity for regular physical activity before, during, and after school. To recognize outstanding public elementary and secondary schools that are implementing an outstanding physical activity program, the Department will recognize and honor exemplary schools through the School Physical Activity Award program. An exemplary school for this award must demonstrate physical activity throughout the day, including physical education classes, physical activity before and after school, physical activity during school hours, family and community engagement activities, and staff involvement.
