

Vision of Teacher and Leader of the Year


Louisiana will be the one of the first states to officially honor an Early Childhood Teacher and Leader of the Year in 2021-2022, and the first to do so through the Department of Education.

In the Early Childhood field, Louisiana strives to achieve the following:

- **Strengthens the child care system** to meet the needs of all families and support the stabilization of the child care sector.
- **Expands supply of and access to high-quality early childhood** options for families and to identify opportunities to sustain that expansion long-term.
- **Prepares and supports teachers** to lead classrooms and provide high-quality interactions that meet the developmental needs of children every day.
- **Empowers families** to access tools and resources to support their children's development.

Early Childhood Matters

The first five years are the most critical in the development of a child's brain. From birth to age three, children grow and learn at the most intense rate, forming more than a million neural connections every second; these are the years when children are learning how to learn. 90% of a child's brain development happens before age 5. [1] Louisiana recognizes that early childhood educators are critical to the success of our children, our economy and our society. It's time to celebrate them!





Teacher and Leader of the Year

Louisiana Department of Education will honor an Early Childhood Teacher and Leader of the Year for the 2021-2022 school year. Louisiana will be the first state honoring the entire Early Childhood Field in this way.

The Early Childhood Teacher and Leader of the Year Process will:

- Mirror the PreK-12 nomination, application, and review process
- Evaluate applicants based on a rigorous, vision-aligned review process that highlights the skills of high-quality educators
- Honor finalists at Teacher Leader Summit 2022
- Award winner(s) with valuable prizes to acknowledge their contributions to the field
- Elevate the field of Early Childhood Education in a way not yet seen in the United States, and position Louisiana as an innovative leader in the field of education




Teacher and Leader of the Year

Louisiana Department of Education will honor an Early Childhood Teacher and Leader of the Year for the 2021-2022 school year. Louisiana will be the first state honoring the entire Early Childhood Field in this way.

Eligible applicants are teachers and leaders serving children in Type III centers, Early Head Start or Head Start Center, or Family Child Care providers (FCC) participating in the FCC Pilot.

The winners will be honored for contributions such as:

- Demonstrating excellence in the field, guiding children of all backgrounds and abilities to achieve excellence.
- Demonstrating leadership and innovation in classrooms and in the community, helping children be successful.
- Creating a culture of growth and development and positivity through collaboration with colleagues, children, families, and community.

The online application portal for both Teacher and Leader of the Year requires applicants to create a basic profile.



The Louisiana Department of Education recognizes that great teachers and leaders are critical to the success of children. Annually, the Department honors the state's most exceptional educators through the Teacher and Leader of the Year programs. These programs provide an opportunity to acknowledge those educators who are achieving excellence in their profession by fostering a nurturing environment in their classroom, where children are learning and developing in a way that prepares them for kindergarten and beyond.


The Louisiana Teacher and Leader of the Year awards programs provide an opportunity to acknowledge those educators who are making exceptional gains with students. Their commitment to student success exemplifies Louisiana's teaching profession.

Criteria- An exemplary candidate for Teacher and Leader of the Year is one who:

- · Demonstrates excellence and expertise in the field, guiding students of all backgrounds and abilities to achieve success.
- Collaborates with colleagues, students, and families to create a school culture that is respectful, inclusive, and positively impacts student growth and learning.
- Intentionally connects the classroom/school and key stakeholders to build strong community partnerships resulting in success for all.
- · Demonstrates leadership and innovation in and outside of the school building walls and helps students/education stakeholders be successful
- Is inspiring, compelling, professional and expresses themselves in an engaging and articulate way. The candidate is both timeless and relevant and has the ability to connect with and represent the state.

A complete state-level application includes:

- Basic information
- Résumé (limit: 2 pages)
- · Responses to one written reflection question and one video prompt
- 2021-2022 student learning targets
- · 2020-2021 student learning targets, with results (or another form of recent student success data)
- · Up to three letters of recommendation
- Candidate consent form
- · Student consent forms (needed for each student included in the application, such as in video/photos/etc.)
- · Additional uploads (Uploads may be in any format, such as a chart, news article, video, photos, etc.)



The application will require you to either type in information, or upload documents, videos, pictures, or PDFs.

For example, you can see the Video Response section provides two options for how to submit your video. You can type in the text box the URL, or click "select file" and upload your video file. Add your YouTube video URL in the textbox below. Note: YouT YouTube video link visibility must be "Public" so the application reviewers may view your video. 





Applications Technical Assistance



The LDOE will support all applicants as much as possible, and encourages lead agencies and CCR&Rs to provide technical assistance to teachers in their region.

The LDOE will provide technical support such as:

- email correspondence for 1-1 questions
- instructions on creating, uploading, and submitting application materials
- Zoom sessions by request for guidance or questions
- optional office hours through October, November, and December

Lead agencies and CCR&Rs should prepare to:

• support with teaching videos and other material preparation as needed

Applications Candidate and Student Consent Forms

Privacy is of the utmost importance for our children, families, and teachers. It is critical to ensure that you have permission from the families and staff before incorporating them in your application.

- Candidates for both TOY and LOY must sign and submit the Department's Candidate Consent Forms in the state-level online application portal.
- Children featured in the application, whether in video, film, audio, photography, recording, etc., must have their guardian sign and return the Department's Child and Family Consent Form.
- If possible, the candidate (teacher or leader) should scan all Child and Family Consent Forms into one PDF and submit that one document in the state-level online application portal. An alternative will be available for those who do not have access to a scanner.




