Nominations Process



Nominations

- Part of the selection process for naming the Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year, the School Health Service Provider of the Year, and the School Physical Activity Award state-level honorees includes recommendations from various stakeholders.
- To assist with this process, a <u>nominations portal</u> was created and was open from August 12-September 12.
- Multiple nominations and self nominations were accepted.
- At the end of the nomination process, the nomination information was sent to local school systems for their consideration in their local-level processes.
- School systems don't have to use this information. Rather, it serves as an extra layer of information.

The application process for the three awards programs:

- Application process opens-September 16, 2025
- Application process closes-December 9, 2025

Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year



Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year

The <u>Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year Award</u> program provides the opportunity to acknowledge those support employees who have rendered time and talents beyond the call of duty. Those candidates include:

- Clerical or custodial personnel
- Food service workers
- Maintenance staff
- Paraprofessionals
- School bus drivers
- Teacher aides
- Other employees who are not required to hold a teacher's certificate as a condition of employment.

Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year - School System Selections

- All school systems are encouraged to select up to three support staff,
 one for elementary, middle, and high, to move to the state process.
- School systems may utilize the state's materials or their own process to identify their support staff selections. For those who don't have a process in place, these selections may come from the nominations information.
- Once school systems identify their system-level honorees, those applications should be entered in the <u>online application portal</u>.
- State-level applications are due by December 9, 2025.



Outstanding School Support Employee of the Year - Application Components

The state-level application includes:

- Basic Information
- Responses to the written reflection questions
- Supplemental materials may be submitted to accompany the written responses and application. (Optional)
- Letter(s) of recommendation (Optional)
- Candidate consent form
- <u>Student consent form</u> (Optional-Needed for each student included in the application, such as in video/photos/etc.)
- School System Approvals

School Health Service Provider of the Year



School Health Service Provider of the Year

The <u>School Health Service Provider of the Year Award</u> provides the opportunity to acknowledge health care providers who have rendered time and talents beyond the call of duty. Those candidates include:

- Occupational therapists
- Physical therapists
- Speech-language pathologists
- Audiologists
- Nurses
- Nurse practitioners
- Licensed practical nurses
- Licensed behavioral providers (LCSW,/LMSW, LPC, psychologists)



School Health Service Provider of the Year - School System Selections

- All school systems are encouraged to select up to five school health service providers — one physical therapist, one occupational therapist, one nurse, one speech therapist, and one psychologist — to submit applications to the state process.
- School systems may utilize the state's materials or their own process to identify their selections. For those who don't have a process in place, these selections may come from the nominations information.
- Once school systems identify their system-level honorees, those applications should be entered in the <u>online application portal</u>.
- State-level applications are due by December 9, 2025.

School Health Service Provider of the Year-Application Components

The application includes:

- Basic information including name, email, and school system
- Applicant provider type (nurse, OT, PT, speech, etc.)
- License type (LMSW, LOTR, DPT, etc.)
- Responses to the six written reflection questions (500 maximum word count per response)
- Links to websites as demonstration of work may be included
- Link(s) to accomplishments that showcase work may be included

School Physical Activity Award

The <u>School Physical Activity Award</u> recognizes elementary and high schools for outstanding physical activity programs available for their students.

The Department recognizes healthy and physically active students have a tendency to have:

- Better grades
- School attendance
- Cognitive performance
- Classroom behaviors



School Physical Activity Award Selection

- All school systems are encouraged nominate schools that provide outstanding physical activity programming before, during, and after school that accommodate all students.
- School systems may utilize the state's materials or their own process to identify schools. For those who don't have a process in place, these selections may come from the nominations information.
- Once school systems identify their system-level honorees, those applications should be entered in the <u>online application portal</u>.
- State-level applications are due by December 9, 2025.
