

School Health Service Provider of the Year Overview

Purpose

The Louisiana Department of Education recognizes that student health plays a vital role in education and that school health providers are the critical link in ensuring health service delivery to students. Through the School Health Service Provider of the Year program, the Department recognizes and celebrates some of the state's most exceptional school health providers. This program provides an opportunity to acknowledge school health service providers who demonstrate superior provision of health services in schools and support the expansion of health services in schools.

Nominations

Through October 12, we are inviting <u>nominations</u> of any of the following school employees or contractors: occupational therapists, physical therapists, speech-language pathologists, audiologists, nurses, nurse practitioners, licensed practical nurses, and licensed behavioral health providers (LCSW/LMSW, LPC, and psychologists).

Criteria

The school health service provider of the year will demonstrate both high quality health service provision and the ability to improve the school health climate in their district or school. This <u>rubric</u> will be used to evaluate candidates.
