

2026-2027 High School Opportunities Guidance

New and developing Career and Technical educators will be provided instructional support, particularly those transitioning from industry into education in regionally high wage, high demand areas. The instructional coach will utilize a structured coaching cycle to guide teachers through reflective practices and continuous improvement. Support will include actionable feedback aligned to the Louisiana Teacher Rubric, purposeful planning, and improving instructional strategies such as transitions and grouping.

Students should be provided high school opportunities to increase academic achievement enabling them to make informed decisions about their paths after graduation.
