Re: NOTICE – LEVEL 2 – Tropical Storm Nicholas

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) would like to inform you that Governor John Bel Edwards has declared a [State of Emergency](#) due to Tropical Storm Nicholas. This system is forecasted to bring heavy rains and flash flooding to the state in the coming days. Areas affected by hurricanes Ida and Laura, and flash flooding earlier in the year, could see impacts from the tropical weather. Additionally, there are still many power outages caused by Hurricane Ida. The LDOE will closely monitor conditions out of concern for your safety and for the safety of the children and families you serve.

If you are a child care provider, please take the following steps to prepare:

- Have access to the appropriate Reopen Request form.

- Review the following for a current list of water systems with [outages](#) or under a [boil-water advisory](#).
- Visit the Louisiana Department of Health's [recommendations](#), [FAQs](#), and [Minimum Standards for Operation](#) if under a boil-water advisory
- Contact your local [GOHSEP office](#) for assistance with bottled water for providers without potable water especially if you provide services for essential workers.
- Review and update evacuation and safety plans.
- Practice evacuation and reunification plans.
- Let families know how you will communicate if you are unable to reopen following a disaster.
- Pay close attention to the messages from your local officials, especially concerning [road closures](#) and hazardous conditions.
