MINIMUM ADMISSION STANDARDS for FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN

These are the <u>minimum</u> admission standards for regular Freshman admission to a Louisiana, public four-year university for **Fall 2014**.

Students should check with the specific institution for additional information about the university's requirements and process for admission.*

1. High School Curriculum = Core 4 Curriculum

Courses in the English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language, and Arts categories listed in Bulletin 741 as *Core 4*.

<u>2.</u> Overall HS GPA = 2.0 (minimum)

3. Developmental Courses Needed = None.

Demonstration of College Readiness: ACT English score = 18 (minimum)

ACT English score = 18 (minimum) ACT Math Score = 19 (minimum)

4. Core GPA	(courses listed above) \rightarrow OR \leftarrow	ACT Composite (minimum)
3.0	LSU A&M	25
2.5	LA Tech, UL Lafayette, UNO	23
