Exam Updates:

- Traditional face-to-face exams will **NOT** take place for the spring 2020 administration. Students will take exams online at home. [The College Board has provided guidance for taking exams at home.](#)
- [The full exam schedule is available on the College Board's website.](#) The testing window is May 11 to May 22.
- Information on accessing exams online will be released by The College Board in late April.
- All exams will be Free Response Questions (FRQ) only. No multiple choice questions will be featured on this exam.
- AP World Language exams will be oral examinations only.
