The College Board has released <u>updated guidance</u> for schools impacted by Coronavirus.

Exam Updates:

- Traditional face-to-face exams will NOT take place for the spring 2020 administration. Students
 will take exams online at home. The College Board has provided guidance for taking exams at
 home.
- <u>The full exam schedule is available on the College Board's website.</u> The testing window is May 11 to May 22.
- Information on accessing exams online will be released by The College Board in late April.
- All exams will be Free Response Questions (FRQ) only. No multiple choice questions will be featured on this exam.
- AP World Language exams will be oral examinations only.
- Students and schools needing technology and connectivity access must complete <u>this form</u> by April 24.

Course Specific Exam Information

- Portfolio due dates have been extended to May 26 at 11:50 p.m. ET for the following courses:

 - AP Research (academic paper only)
 - o AP Seminar
