LOOKING FOR CHILD CARE?

View a list of the most up-to-date [child care providers open in the state](#). You can click on the parish and drill down to centers and family homes that are open. Each location will have contact information. If non-traditional hours are needed, we encourage you to contact the provider as they may be able to work with your schedule. Note that Type III early learning centers can take children of families that qualify for the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) – see below for more information on CCAP.

If you have either a person that cares for children in her home or a person that comes to your house to care for your children, they can become certified with the Department of Education by following [2 easy steps](#). The Louisiana Department of Education will pay family home and in-home providers the same rates as Type III early learning centers – see below for rates and parent responsibility.
