Working with Words Reading Decodable and High Frequency Words

Decodable words are phonetically regular. This means they can be sounded out and blended.

High-frequency words are words that occur most frequently. Most high-frequency words can be sounded out. Some high-frequency words have little meaning on their own but contribute to the overall sentence.




Working with Words

Reading decodable words

Decodable words are words that are phonetically regular. This means they follow one of the six syllable rules in English.

Majority of text the words can be identified with common sounds.

Reminder students should never attempt to guess at any words when they are reading. Have your student attempt to sound out any unknown word.
