

## **Home Study Decision Making**

Louisiana families may choose to educate their children independently from the public or nonpublic school system. Families in Louisiana can provide independent education through a <u>BESE-Approved Home Study Program</u> or a <u>Nonpublic School Not Seeking State Approval</u>. The graphic below can help in determining the best pathway for your child.
