

**Directions:** Programs proposing to use an assessment in place of *GOLD*<sup>©</sup> must complete and submit this waiver application by Friday, July 21, 2018 to <u>ivy.starns@la.gov</u>. The assessment must include domains in *GOLD*<sup>©</sup>: Social-Emotional, Physical, Language/Literacy, Cognitive (Approaches to Learning), Math, Science/Technology, Social Studies and Arts.

Programs with approved waivers will be expected to provide results on the <u>LDE template</u>.

Programs using the assessments embedded in a Tier I or Tier II curriculum **DO NOT** need to submit an assessment waiver application, and should continue to use the *GOLD*<sup>©</sup> system.

Documentation from curriculum assessment should be uploaded into children's portfolio created in the *GOLD*<sup>©</sup> system.

NOTE: Waivers are granted for a period of one year, and programs must reapply in subsequent years.
