Child Care Management Software Initiative (CCMSi)
<b>What:</b> Eligible providers that purchase a new annual subscription to a Tier 1 CCMS identified in the LDOE <u>CCMS Guidebook</u> , will be reimbursed for up to 80% of the cost (for a maximum reimbursement of \$1,000). CCMS purchases are made directly by the provider with the software vendor and reimbursements are processed through the local <u>CCR&amp;R</u> .
<b>Who:</b> All Type III providers or CCAP-certified family child care sites who either are preparing to use CCMS through the Child Care Management Software Initiative (CCMSi).
When: The LDOE will permit reimbursements for <b>new</b> annual subscriptions purchased between <b>July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023.</b>
