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# **CHILD CARE CURRICULUM INITIATIVE**

To improve kindergarten readiness, the Louisiana Department of Education is supporting Type III and Family Child Care providers that opt into Academic Approval by reimbursing a portion of the cost for Tier I Early Childhood Curriculum.

# STEP 1 I PURCHASE HIGH-QUALITY CURRICULUM

- ✓ Review the Guidance on choosing high-quality curriculum.
- ✓ Purchase an Infant/Toddler and/or pre-K curriculum kit from the list of approved curricula. KEEP INOVICE(S) AND DELIVERY RECEIPT(S).

# STEP 2 -> CONTACT YOUR LOCAL CHILD CARE RESOURCE & REFERRAL AGENCY

- ✓ Complete an application and sign assurances.
- ✓ Complete an Implementation Plan.
- ✓ Provide receipts for the purchased curriculum.
- ✓ Get reimbursed for 80% (*maximum \$5,000*) of the cost of the curriculum.

# STEP 3 I FOLLOW UP WITH TRAINING AND CURRICULUM IMPLEMENTATION

- ✓ Participate in a general training on implementing a curriculum through your CCR&R Agency.
- ✓ Provide updates and reports as requested by your CCR&R Agency, and state office.

# STEP 4 ITRAIN TEACHERS ON CURRICULUM

- Provide high-quality curriculum and materials to teachers with adequate training and time so they are prepared to use these tools.
- Ensure all other classroom materials not included with the curriculum support children's learning and development as aligned to Louisiana's Early Learning and Development Standards.
- Ensure any additional professional development supports the instructional approaches and strategies found in the curriculum.

# STEP 5 → ENTER CURRICULUM INFORMATION INTO THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CLASS® PORTAL

- ✓ Enter High-Quality Curriculum information into the appropriate field for all classrooms.
- ✓ Contact <u>earlychildhood@la.gov</u> if there are any challenges entering this information.

# **GUIDANCE FOR SELECTING THE RIGHT CURRICULUM FOR YOUR PROGRAM:**

In Louisiana, early childhood providers are able to choose instructional materials that are best for their children and families. The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) supports choosing curricula appropriate for children age birth to five that are grounded in helping teachers provide quality interactions and instruction. Through a rigorous evaluation process, the LDOE rates curriculum based on:

• Quality and complexity of learning

- Alignment to Louisiana's Birth to Five Standards
- Ease of use by staff

- Potential for individualizing instruction
- Developmental appropriateness

- Cultural and linguistic sensitivityOptions for family engagement
- activitiesEmbedded assessment

Note that early learning sites in Louisiana can choose any curricula they prefer. However, as part of the *Child Care Curriculum Initiative*, early childhood providers are only eligible to receive reimbursement for the purchase and implementation of the LDOE approved curriculum. These resources are highly recommended because they meet all criteria and indicators of quality, and they support interactions and effective instruction.

# BEFORE CHOOSING A CURRICULUM, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT SITE LEADERS

- 1. Read the **online reviews** and compare unique features of each.
- 2. Preview the high-quality curriculum through the publisher websites (see the names and links in the chart below).
- 3. Conduct a meeting with staff and share information about the curriculum. Assess their ability to and interest in successfully implementing the curriculum.
  - Would materials and activities be easy for them to follow?
  - Would teachers use the embedded assessments to help them plan?
  - Would teachers use guidance for communicating with families on their child's education and care?

# DESCRIPTION OF MANIPULATIVES/RESOURCES INCLUDED IN BASIC CURRICULUM PACKAGE:

Every Child Ready is a balanced early learning program created to prepare three-and-four-year-old children for kindergarten and beyond. The Every Child Ready program supports children's development across social-emotional, physical, cognitive, and academic areas. The curriculum includes:

- Early childhood program consultation and coaching, including foundational knowledge and vision setting. Includes the Priority Planning Process to inform customized support.
- A two-year differentiated curriculum for three-and four-year-olds that includes 10 thematic units, a flexible small group model, diverse print materials, and a balanced daily schedule.
- Professional learning for leaders and teachers that includes differentiated classroom coaching, summer training, and quarterly instructional leader workshop.
- A suite of measurement tools to support decision making in the classroom for social emotional and academic learning. Also includes measurement to support classroom quality.

#### Frog Street Infant Curriculum 0-18 Months\*

Dr. Bailey's Conscious Discipline guidelines are integrated into all three programs to build continuity.

The program is designed equipping and fostering caregivers in essential growth, meeting the needs of all learners, and embracing the joy of learning each day. Frog Street Toddler includes 13 thematic activity guides that offer hundreds of domain-based activity choices ,which are intentional, integrated, and child centered. Toddlers will be immersed in a language-rich environment essential for developing both receptive and expressive language skills. Frog Street Toddler offers activities supporting cause-and-effect, providing toddlers with fun physical challenges with special emphasis placed on social emotional development via the integration of Conscious Discipline. In addition, Frog Street Toddler supports children at many developmental levels and embedded professional development provides numerous opportunities for enriched understanding for teachers.

#### Frog Street Threes Ages 36-48 months

Frog Street Threes is designed around the latest brain research and is a comprehensive bridge between Frog Street Toddler and Frog Street Pre-K. Dr. Pam Schiller is the senior author of all three programs, in which Dr. Becky Bailey's Conscious Discipline is utilized. Dr. Bailey's Conscious Discipline guidelines are integrated into all three programs to build continuity.

Each week of instructio n is neatly organized into a 10-page section of activity choices. The first page of each 10-page section offers an overview of the week's theme, the Wonderful Word of the Week, the Week at a Glance, a list of materials to gather, and things to make and do in preparation for the week's activities. Greeting Circle activities encourage children to participate in "brain smart" activities that set the tone for their emotional well-being and challenge them to focus on pro-social skills. The morning message is designed to teach foundational literacy skills. Frog Street Threes offers literacy lessons using Read-Alouds as a springboard. Frog Street Threes provides a bridge between toddlerhood and preschool. Music and movement activities are included in the daily routine. Math skills are presented throughout the program along a continuum that allows children to take what they know about one concept and apply it to the next. A STEAM lesson is offered with each week of instruction. STEAM is an acronym for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math. Practice centers (learning centers) are small-group workstations. The purpose of the Closing Circle is to reflect upon and review the activities of the day. Regular communication is the key to having successful partnerships with families. In week 1 of each theme, you will be reminded to reproduce and send home theme letters, Parents Are Teachers Tool mats, and the numbered Family Connections Cards.

Frog Street Threes includes nine thematic teaching guides offering 36 weeks of easy-to-use instruction created specifically for three-year- olds. Each guide begins with a theme overview outlining all four weeks of instruction in that theme.

Program components include a literature library (English titles, Spanish titles, a bilingual development storybook, magnetic bilingual Story Folders, Conscious Discipline titles). In addition, vocabulary cards, photo activity cards, "Sing and Read" Alphabet eStories, hands-on card sets and letter cards. Math manipulatives and CDs with Storage Case. Fernando plush puppet is integral to the curriculum and the class.

#### Frog Street Pre-K 3-5 Years Old

Frog Street Pre-K is a comprehensive, research-based curriculum that integrates instruction across developmental domains and is aligned to state and national standards. . Dr. Pam Schiller is the senior author of all three programs, in which Dr. Becky Bailey's Conscious Discipline is utilized. Dr. Bailey's Conscious Discipline guidelines are integrated into all three programs to build continuity.

The cornerstones of the curriculum include integrated lessons, social-emotional development using Conscious Discipline, differentiated instruction and a joyful approach to learning. Frog Street Pre-K includes nine thematic guides offering 180 day of instruction for a full-year program.

Frog Street Pre-K English and Bilingual Curricula each include a Welcome to Frog Street Pre-K Guide. A comprehensive explanation of each learning center is included in the guide. Learning centers in Frog Street Pre-K allow children to practice skills learned in whole-class and small-group instruction, learn independence, self-direction, and collaboration skills, work at their own level, practice decision making and receive individualized teacher scaffolding daily. Examples of learning centers and accompanying materials, are the ABC Center (Photo Pockets with Pockets Letters), Language and Literacy Center (sequence cards, rebus posters, and story folder props), Math Center (frog counters, pattern blocks, connecting cubes, attribute buttons and pocket cube with dot cards and Technology Center (Frog Street Pre-K Interactive Software). In addition, common supplies to gather are included in the learning center descriptions. Also, ideas for learning centers can be found in the teacher guides. Fanny Frog Puppet is integral to the curriculum and the class.

Connect4Learning (C4L) is an interdisciplinary early childhood prekindergarten curriculum, funded by the National Science Foundation, which aims to synthesize research-based approaches in four domains of learning: literacy, mathematics, science, and social-emotional development. C4L uses an interdisciplinary approach to address growing concerns that the majority of preschool instructional time is devoted to literacy at the expense of other content areas, particularly math and science. The curriculum consists of six units and 32 weeks of learning centers and lessons.C4L also includes all of the specific items required to implement the curriculum, including both classroom materials and a book collection. Each kit contains more than 100 items and features dozens of custom-made pieces unique to the curriculum.
