

TeachingStrategies® Platform Updates: Redesigned Manage Experience in SmartTeach™

SmartTeach™ has launched phase one of a refreshed version of the "Manage" tab in the admin panel. This update is designed to provide administrators a clearer, more intuitive way to oversee programs.

- Administrators are encouraged to review the <u>Introducing the New Manage Experience Webinar</u>, focusing on how program leaders can work more efficiently with the new Manage interface. The webinar provides a walkthrough of the redesigned interface and improved navigation.
- Currently, to import children or to modify your checkpoint dates, use the Classic Experience.
- The Classic Experience will be replaced with the New Experience after a second release launches in September.
- Administrators will be able to emulate teacher accounts in the new experience after the September release. Continue using the Classic Experience until September.
- Current data entered in either the New Experience or the Classic Experience will be exchanged
 and work together.








- As a reminder, Bulletin 140 requires that all observations are scheduled in the EC CLASS® Portal by October 1, 2025.

Coordinated Observation Plan

Local Protocol Documents

- The Fall 2025 Local Observation Protocol Guidance provides Community Network Lead Agencies with observation protocols for the Fall 2025 observation cycle.
- For the most recent updates related to the Fall 2025 coordinated observation plan guidance, please visit the CLASS® Observations page on the LDOF website and continue to refresh the linked PDF document.

Observation Protocol Submissions

- As in 2024-2025, the Department will utilize a Jotform instead of a document submission.
- Lead agencies should specify that they plan to adhere to LDOE's observation protocol and any community network-specific procedures that will be implemented for the 2025-2026 academic year.

Observation Protocol Updates

The "Observation Protocol Updates" are comprised of four sections:

- Before the Observation Begins
- The Day of the Observation
- Additional Requirements
- Resources

CNLAs should review observation guidance with all program partners prior to the start of observation (and, best practice, prior to submission of the protocol to the LDOE), to ensure programs are fully aware of the local requirements.

Observation Protocol Specifics

- Bulletin 140 requires that no one with a direct financial interest in a site can conduct observations. This includes child care center owners observing their own site.
- For mixed-age classrooms, the observer should use the tool corresponding to the age (as of 10/1/25) of the majority of the children present on the day of the observation.
- The LDOE does not prescribe a specific policy or protocol for local appeals: however, new this year, CNLAs must submit to the LDOE their local procedure for appeal. This procedure shall allow sites to elevate concerns in a timely manner and provides time to review concerns before observation data is finalized for the 2025-2026 academic year.




- The coordinated observation plan is due by October 1, 2025.


- **NEW** The New Early Learning and Development Standards (ELDS) -1 credit hour
