### **Early Childhood Updates**

Wednesday May 15, the LDOE will share preliminary notice of award for the following allocations that are pending approval by BESE on June 11:

All allocations, pending BESE approval, will be available in eGMS on July 1, 2024.



#### **CCAP B-3 Seats Updates**

On Tuesday, April 30, the LDOE hosted a webinar for CCAP B-3 Seats close out and following that on May 2nd and 3rd, the LDOE offered additional Office Hours to Networks.

### TS GOLD<sup>®</sup> Checkpoint Completion

The Spring TS GOLD<sup>®</sup> checkpoint is May 31, 2024. The Department has set program expectations of completion for each checkpoint. Networks should monitor completion rates at the site and classroom levels. This assessment is mandated through program assurances and included within Bulletin 140:

Sites ensure all required information for classrooms containing children from birth to five years is entered in the GOLD® online system. Additionally, all child assessment results for publicly-funded infants, toddlers, and pre-K children must be entered and checkpoints finalized by October 31, February 28, and May 31.

<b>Fall 2023</b> (October 31)	<b>Winter 2024</b> (February 28)	<b>Spring 2024</b> (May 31)
80%	85%	90%



#### TS GOLD® OSEP Monitoring

Program OSEP administrators should monitor sites, classrooms, and users to ensure checkpoint completion.

For each checkpoint, OSEP Administrators should:

- ensure that all children have an entry date reported;
- ensure that all current students that have an IEP are marked "yes" as having an IEP. OSEP administrators are encouraged to cross-check SER each month for children with new IEPs to ensure data for all children is accurately reported;
- ensure that all children with an IEP have the 4 extra objectives. These objectives include 1c1, 1c2, 1c3, and 1c4. When the child's profile is marked "yes" for IEP, the system adds these objectives to the child's report and they are mandatory for OSEP reporting purposes. These objectives cannot be finalized unless they are leveled.

#### TS GOLD® OSEP Monitoring

For each checkpoint, OSEP Administrators should ensure that:

- children with an IEP do not have any objectives leveled with "Not Observed." "Not Observed" is a null value. These children must be leveled as "Not Yet" or leveled accordingly; and
- all children with an IEP that are being reported to OSEP will have to have at least two completed checkpoints by the end of the year or they will not be in the OSEP Mandatory Report.

# **Early Childhood Reminders**



#### 2023-2024 Lead Teacher Survey

The Department released the 2023-2024 Lead Teacher Survey on April 23, 2024. The purpose of this survey is to gather feedback based on the current academic year. The Department will publish information on teacher support as part of the Community Network Performance Profiles released in November 2024.

- Lead teachers received a link to the survey via their email address in TS GOLD®.
- The survey will close on May 15.
- Networks should remind all program partners to ensure lead teachers complete this survey.

### **Spring 2024 CLASS® Observation Updates**

Community Network Lead Agencies (CNLAs) should plan to complete and enter all observations by May 15, 2024, the deadline for the Spring Observation Period.

CNLAs can receive updates on observation completion via the "Reports" section of the Early Childhood CLASS® Portal, "System Level Reports" including the:

- Community Network CLASS® Observations Completion Report,
- Community Network CLASS® Observations Planned Report, and
- Community Network CLASS® Observations Missing Report.

#### **Early Childhood Reminders**

The current State Fiscal Year is coming to a close. There are **54** calendar days until June 30. Between now and June 30, CNLAs must:

- Submit reimbursements for the end of the fiscal year to get allocation as close to a \$0 balance as possible
- Collect and prepare documentation to submit with the June 30 PER
- Ensure all budget amendments that are needed or pending are submitted and approved by the LDOE
