

2025 Early Childhood Conference Overview

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) is excited to host the 2025 Early Childhood Conference – *Early Foundations, Endless Possibilities*! The conference will take place on September 13 at the Raising Cane's River Center in Baton Rouge and on October 11 at the Shreveport Convention Center in Shreveport.

Content and Audiences

This conference will provide early childhood professionals from all backgrounds and levels of experience with information and training related to a vast variety of topics that are relevant to early care and education, including:

- Removing barriers and access equitable, inclusive learning experiences for young children with disabilities
- Increasing family and caregiver engagement and empowering families to access tools and resources to support their children's development
- Building and supporting the early childhood workforce through effective recruitment and retention strategies
- Supporting early childhood teachers through evidence-based mentoring and coaching
- Developing childcare directors' leadership skills
- Becoming an active participant in community-level early childhood efforts
- Expanding access to care through innovative strategies

Registration

Early Bird registration will end on June 25, 2025. Regular registration will begin on **June 26, 2025**, and close on August 6, 2025, for the Baton Rouge Conference or September 17, 2025, for the Shreveport Conference, or at sellout.

Registration Fees

To help offset the cost of running a high-quality event for hundreds of Louisiana educators, the LDOE charges a nominal registration fee for the Early Childhood Conference. This fee will cover:

Participants can pay for their registration fee in Whova using Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or AMEX. The LDOE does not accept cash, checks, money orders, or purchase orders for this event.

Waitlist

There will be no waitlist for the 2025 Early Childhood Conference. Should any remaining seats be available after registration closes, the LDOE will re-open the registration window for approximately two (2) weeks.

Presenting at the Early Childhood Conference

The Louisiana Department of Education will accept applications to be a presenter at the Early Childhood Conference until **May 30.** The application is now closed.

Sessions

Educators will have the opportunity to choose from more than 50 sessions led by content experts, including but not limited to the LDOE staff and partner organizations. The LDOE will release the full session list and open session selection via Whova a few weeks prior to each conference date.

Registered participants must reserve seats for sessions in advance via the Whova app. Registrants will receive an email when the app goes live.

Parking

Parking is available at and around the conference venues. All overnight parking is prohibited. It is encouraged for attendees to walk, utilize ridesharing services, or carpool.

Health and Safety

Creating a healthy and safe environment for all participants is of the utmost importance and concern to the LDOE. View safety and helpful information for Shreveport here, and for Baton Rouge here.

Tips for Visitors to Any Major City

- Travel in groups and avoid walking alone on unlit streets at night.
- Pay attention when walking and using a smartphone, as these devices have been the target of thieves nationwide.
- Do not leave belongings such as a purse, backpack, or briefcase unattended, especially not on the back of a chair.
- Be on the lookout for pickpockets. Consolidate items such as a wallet, and do not bring every credit card. Move wallets to a front pocket and/or wear a cross-body bag rather than a shoulder strap to ensure that it is placed in front. Do not display large amounts of cash in public places.
- Consider removing IDs such as a convention badge when leaving the hotel or meeting venue.
- When hailing a ride via a mobile app, confirm the identity of the driver before getting into the car.
- Trust gut instincts. If someone or something seems suspicious, leave the area and alert a
 police officer. Do not participate. Simply smile and walk past them.
- Lock car doors. Stow valuables out of sight in a vehicle.
- Ensure that the hotel room door is fully closed and always locked.
- Do not leave a drink unattended or accept drinks from strangers.
- Remember that most laws enforced in other cities are enforced in New Orleans as well.

What to Bring

In preparing for the Early Childhood Conference, the LDOE encourages the following items:

- Sweater or other long-sleeved covering
- Chargers for mobile devices, tablets, and laptops
- Computer/pen and paper for notetaking
- An umbrella in case of inclement weather
- Comfortable walking shoes
