

Workforce Child Care Tax Credits FAQs for Parents and Families

Formerly School Readiness Tax Credits (SRTC)

1. What is the Workforce Child Care Tax Credit (WCCTC) for parents?

The WCCTC is an additional state child care tax credit for taxpayers with children who are under the age of 6 and are enrolled in a child care center that has earned at least 2 stars in Louisiana's Quality Rating and Improvement System. The amount of the tax credit increases with the number of stars that the child care center has earned. 2. How does a family claim WCCTC?

The Louisiana Department of Revenue will create a credit certificate that participating and qualifying child care centers will provide to each family claiming the child care tax credit (taxpayer). The credit certificate will consist of a provider portion of the certificate and a taxpayer portion of the certificate.

Provider Portion

No later than January 31, the child care provider will complete the provider portion of the credit certificate and will give each taxpayer who had a child at the facility during the previous calendar year. The provider portion of the credit certificate will include the following information: the child care facility name, the child care facility star rating, the child care facility Louisiana tax identification number, the child care facility license number, the name of the child attending the facility and the issue date and effective year. The provider will submit to the Department of Revenue a list of all taxpayers to whom a certificate was issued.

Taxpayer Portion

The taxpayer will then complete the taxpayer portion of the certificate which will include the following information: the name and social security number of the taxpayer claiming the credit and the name, social security number and date of birth for the qualifying child for whom this credit is claimed on the tax return. The taxpayer must submit or maintain the certificate as required by the Secretary of the Department of Revenue in subsequent forms and instructions.

3. How do I file for the Workforce Child Care Tax Credit?

You must contact your tax preparer or the Louisiana Department of Revenue for information on filing taxes.

5. How are star levels determined?

Each participating child care center earns a rating based on specified CLASS® quality measures and assessments.

6. Who is eligible for the parent WCCTC?

Eligible taxpayers must have incurred child care expenses for one or more children, under the age of six, who are enrolled in a licensed child care center that has earned at least 2 stars in the Louisiana Unified Quality Rating System by December 31st of the tax year.

7. Can I still receive the WCCTC if my child turns 6 during the year?

Yes. As long as your child was age 5 at some point during the year then the child care expenses incurred for that child are eligible. This includes if your child turned 6 on January 2, of the tax year.

8. What if my child attended different child care centers throughout the year and they all had different ratings?

If a child attends multiple centers throughout the year, then the center with the highest star rating is used to determine the WCCTC.

9. How much can a family earn and still be eligible for the tax credit?

All families are eligible to receive some level of credit as long as they pay for at least one child under the age of 6 to attend a center-based early childhood program that has attained at least a 2 star rating.
