Acadia, Ascension, Avoyelles, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, St. James, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermillion, Washington, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana.

If your child care center or family day home/in-home location is situated in any of the above parishes, your center MUST complete the form linked below and submit it to the LDE by5:00 PM on August 23, 2016. Failure to do so may result in suspension of your license/certification.
