The Communications Director manages all communication between the Department of Education and a diverse audience across Louisiana and the nation. It is the job of the Communications Director to translate the Louisiana Believe plan into multi-media communications that inform and invest students, parents, educators, taxpayers, and policy makers.

The Communications Director is responsible for the following activities:

- Creating and managing communications plans and calendars for all Department communications.
- Advising the State Superintendent of Education on communications strategy.
- Providing daily contact for reporters and other members of the public interested in information regarding education in Louisiana.
- Drafting and editing press releases, op-eds, speeches, and other critical written materials.
- Coordinating speeches, visits, tours, and other in-person events central to the communications strategy.
- Designing specific, multi-media campaigns around high-priority strategies and programs.
- Creating and maintaining a web presence for the Department, alongside a presence on Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, and other social media vehicles that help to communicate the agency's mission and message.
- Overseeing a process to provide timely public records when requested.
- Manage a team of three to accomplish the above functions.
- Serving as a member of the Department's Executive Team, and thus participating in senior-level policy making.

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree. References and writing samples should be available upon request.

Preferred Qualifications:

Successful applicants will have demonstrated the ability to strategize, innovate, and write in challenging environments. Applicants need not have a background specifically in education policy, but applicants should have a strong interest in improving the prospects of Louisiana's children and in positive changes necessary to achieve that ideal.

Previous management of teams or departments is beneficial but not required.
