Accessing the Modules: Quick Start Guide

To access Canopy, Louisiana educators must complete a short setup process to protect user data and ensure proper reporting. Follow the steps below to get started.

Step 1: Create My.LA Credentials

Visit My.LA.gov to create an account. You will receive an email to verify your credentials. If you've already created an account, use the Help feature to retrieve your login information instead of creating a new one.

Step 2: Create Your EdLink User Profile

Log in to the EdLink Ops Portal using your My.LA credentials. Complete the New User Profile fields, including account type, contact information, and personal identification. This connects your StaffID to Canopy for accurate course reporting. Then log in to EdLink Security to activate your account.

Step 3: Request Canopy Permissions

In EdLink Security, select 'Permissions Request' > 'General User Access' > 'K-12 Public Schools' > 'Canopy'. Choose your role (District or School) and location. All users must request 'Learner' access; add 'Instructor' or 'Admin' as needed. Your District Data Manager must approve the request. Permissions are updated nightly.

Step 4: Log in to Canopy via EdLink

Once approved, sign in to EdLink Security and select Canopy. Use your LDOE login to access the platform. You may now join courses using course codes, browse the course catalog, or follow collections.

Ways to Join Courses

- Join with a Course Code: Select '+ Join Course', enter the code, and confirm.
- Browse the Course Catalog: Available if your StaffID is connected. Search and enroll.
- Follow Collections: Use filters in the catalog, then select 'Follow' or 'Join Collection'.

Accessing & Completing Coursework

Find courses from the navigation menu, Curriculum tab, or My Coursework tab. Use icons to track progress. Submit responses using the flower icon; full color means submitted. Mark sections complete to receive credit. Use notes and 'Collapse All Lessons' for easier navigation.
