# Overview

- The CSPR is a required annual reporting tool that is authorized under the amended Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESSA).
- Title III supported programs are subject to additional federal and state oversight.
- The CSPR is a way for states to collect data on certain federal programs, for monitoring, and to identify technical assistance needs.

# Overview Continued

LIEP-Language Instruction Education Programs are required to meet certain goals of ESSA.

***Performance Goal 2:*** All limited English proficient students will become proficient in English and reach high academic standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics.

The CSPR collects data from the previous year and opens in the late fall of each year.



# Overview Continued

All school systems receiving Title III funds, either as a stand-alone or as a member of a Title III consortium must submit data for the CSPR.



# Data Collection for the 2023-2024 CSPR

The LDOE has created a specialized application in eGMS to collect the data for the 23-24 CSPR.

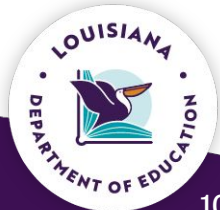

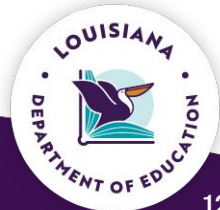


# Student Counts

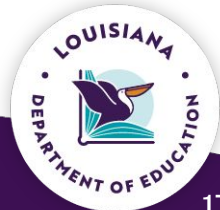
