Overview

- The CSPR is a required annual reporting tool that is authorized under the amended Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESSA).
- Title III supported programs are subject to additional federal and state oversight.
- The CSPR is a way for states to collect data on certain federal programs, for monitoring, and to identify technical assistance needs.

Overview Continued

LIEP-Language Instruction Education Programs are required to meet certain goals of ESSA.

Performance Goal 2: All limited English proficient students will become proficient in English and reach high academic standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics.

The CSPR collects data from the previous year and opens in the late fall of each year.

Overview Continued

All school systems receiving Title III funds, either as a stand-alone or as a member of a Title III consortium must submit data for the CSPR.



Data Collection for the 2023-2024 CSPR

The LDOE has created a specialized application in eGMS to collect the data for the 23-24 CSPR.



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Creating the Application

As with the creation of any new application, first verify the ESSA contact information in LEA Central data, and save the page.

"Title III EL" application will appear in Formula Grant section towards bottom of GMS Select page.



On first page, select "Program Specific" tab






Data Entry


