

**Jumpstart 2.0 Apprenticeship: Youth Restaurant**  
*Apprenticeship Partner: Louisiana Restaurant Association*

**Overview**

Through a partnership with Louisiana Restaurant Association (LRA) and National Restaurant Association, students will have the opportunity to gain on-the-job training through pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship experience. Pre-apprenticeship (11<sup>th</sup> Grade) - During students' Prostart classes representatives from the LRA will conduct a pre-apprenticeship which gives students mini-lessons on apprenticeship soft skills and requirements. Students will spend the rest of their day earning the credentials and work experience needed to obtain the ManageFirst Professional credential. School systems are encouraged to partner with post-secondary institutions that offer these certifications to allow students to earn dual enrollment credit and credentials simultaneously. Apprenticeship (12<sup>th</sup> Grade) – Students move on to a full apprenticeship starting the summer prior to their senior year. The apprenticeship will provide students with on-the-job work experience as either a Line Cook, Kitchen Manager, or Restaurant Manager. LRA partners (such as The Windsor Court, Wakin Bakin, Zea Rotisserie & Bar, Link Restaurant Group, Brennan's Restaurant Group, QED Hospitality, and Raising Canes) will host student apprentices. Students will be required to complete a checklist of competencies in order to remain in the apprenticeship beyond high school.
