



Pathway: Jump Start 2.0 Apprenticeship: Pipe Trades Apprenticeship Partner: Steamfitters and Pipefitters Union

Overview:

Pipe Trades Apprenticeship program combines work-based, on-the-job learning with relevant technical education in the classroom and shop. Students who complete the two year Fast Forward program and successfully graduate, will have earned two years of apprenticeship credit toward the Pipe Trades registered Apprenticeship program. During the third year, all students will be offered a preferential interview; students will enter the program as a 3rd year - 1st semester apprentice. Once students enter the program between third year, first semester to the fifth year, second semester of the apprenticeship program they will earn: Med gas certification, LA Natural gas license, LA Plumbing license, Backflow certification, Mech B certification, Industrial EPRI rigging certification, and Foreman certification. At the beginning of the third year, first semester, students will receive full-time employment which entails forty-hour employment with benefits.
