

Jumpstart 2.0 Associate of Applied Science: Care and Development of Young Children Postsecondary: Nunez Community College

Overview

This pathway aligns to the LDOE pre-educator pathway in an effort to grow a teacher workforce from our own students. The Care and Development of Young Children program provides education and training in the care of young children. A student who completes this program is prepared to assure the health, safety, and well-being of young children who are in out-of-home care. Students completing the AAS in CDYC can then apply for the Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate with LDOE, which is needed for the lead teachers and directors in early childcare programs in LA.
