Overview

The Associate of Science in Teaching program introduces students to the field of teaching by focusing on professional responsibilities of educators and the development of elementary school children. The primary topics addressed are: Professional Issues for Education Careers, Child Development, and Technology for Teaching and Learning. The program was created to ensure a smooth transition from a Board of Regents approved AST (grades 1-5) degree program at a regionally accredited public community college to a Board of Regents approved Bachelors of Science in Teaching (Grades 1-5) degree program at a regionally accredited four-year public institution.
