3. Tailor topics for different audiences. Not every student wants to pursue the same career!
4. Communicate the schedule in advance. A lunchroom calendar with sign-up is a great idea! And don't forget to send class passes/notes as a reminder.
5. Select a quiet location that supports student learning and eating.
