Thank you for joining us for the 2017 Super Summer Institute. This week kicks off an exciting year for Jump Start that includes:

- Students graduating for the first time with either a TOPS University Diploma or a Jump Start Career Diploma. Many students will take advantage of courses and experiences from both pathways, enabling students who earn industry-based credentials to continue their education after high school.
- The first "K-16" Jump Start Pathway – Pre-Engineering – will be implemented in the Capital Region, while stakeholders across the state collaborate to develop and launch additional K-16 pathways in Entrepreneurship, IT/Coding and Education.
- This year's pilot Jump Start Summers programs – where students earned academic credits and industry-based credentials, while honing their workplace "soft skills" and receiving a summer wage – will be expanded next summer to more students in more schools systems.
- An increase in the number of students participating in high-quality workplace-based learning through interactions with in-person and virtual mentors, including workplace experts dedicated to mentoring students with disabilities and students in alternative school settings.

All of these innovations – and more – are propelled by teachers like you who are earning critical industry-based credentials, and then helping our students pursue career pathways that meet their interests and needs, and earning industry-based credentials towards those professions.

Thank you once again to our hosts, South Louisiana Community College, Louisiana Community and Technical College System, and the Lafayette Parish School System.

And thank you, Louisiana educators, for transforming K-12 education in Louisiana.

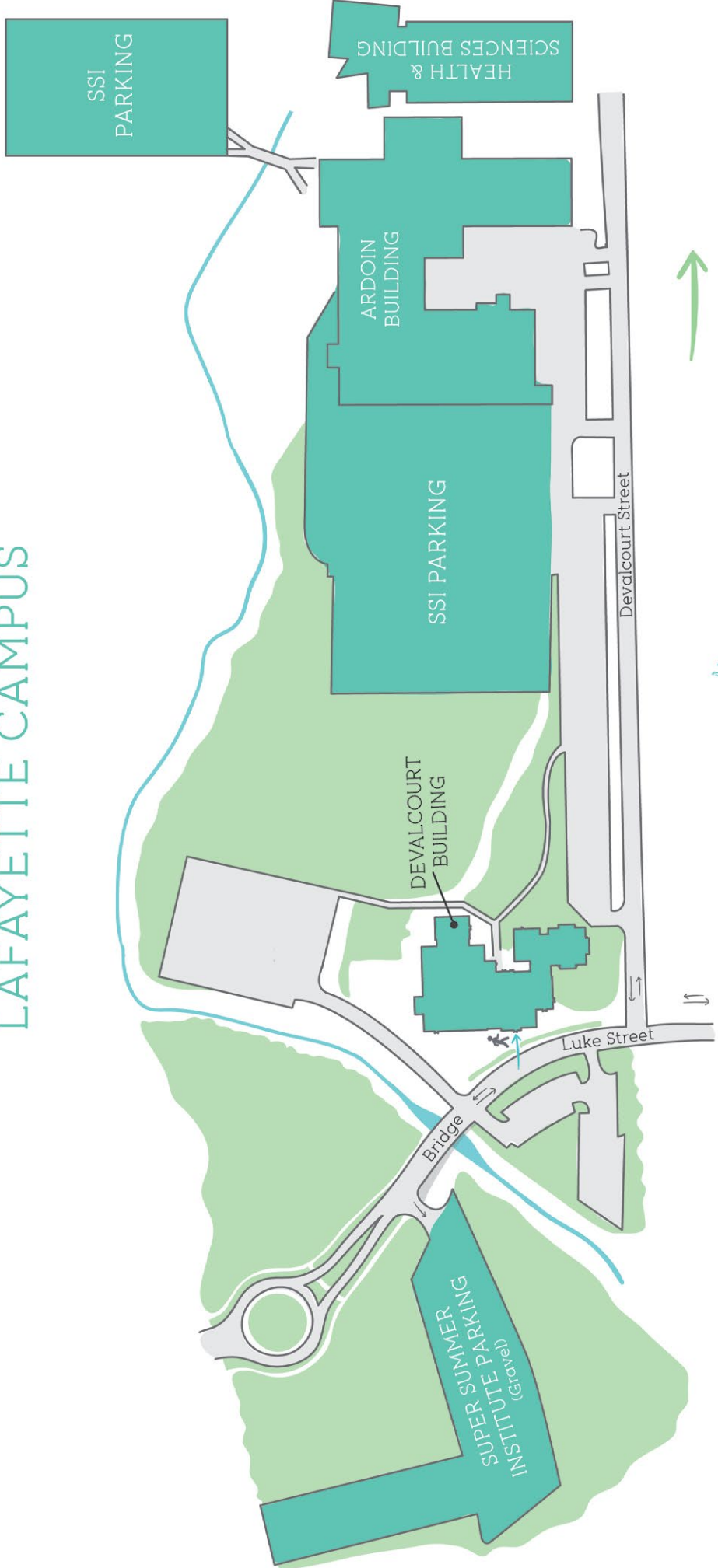

SUPER SUMMER INSTITUTE PARKING AND OVERVIEW MAP

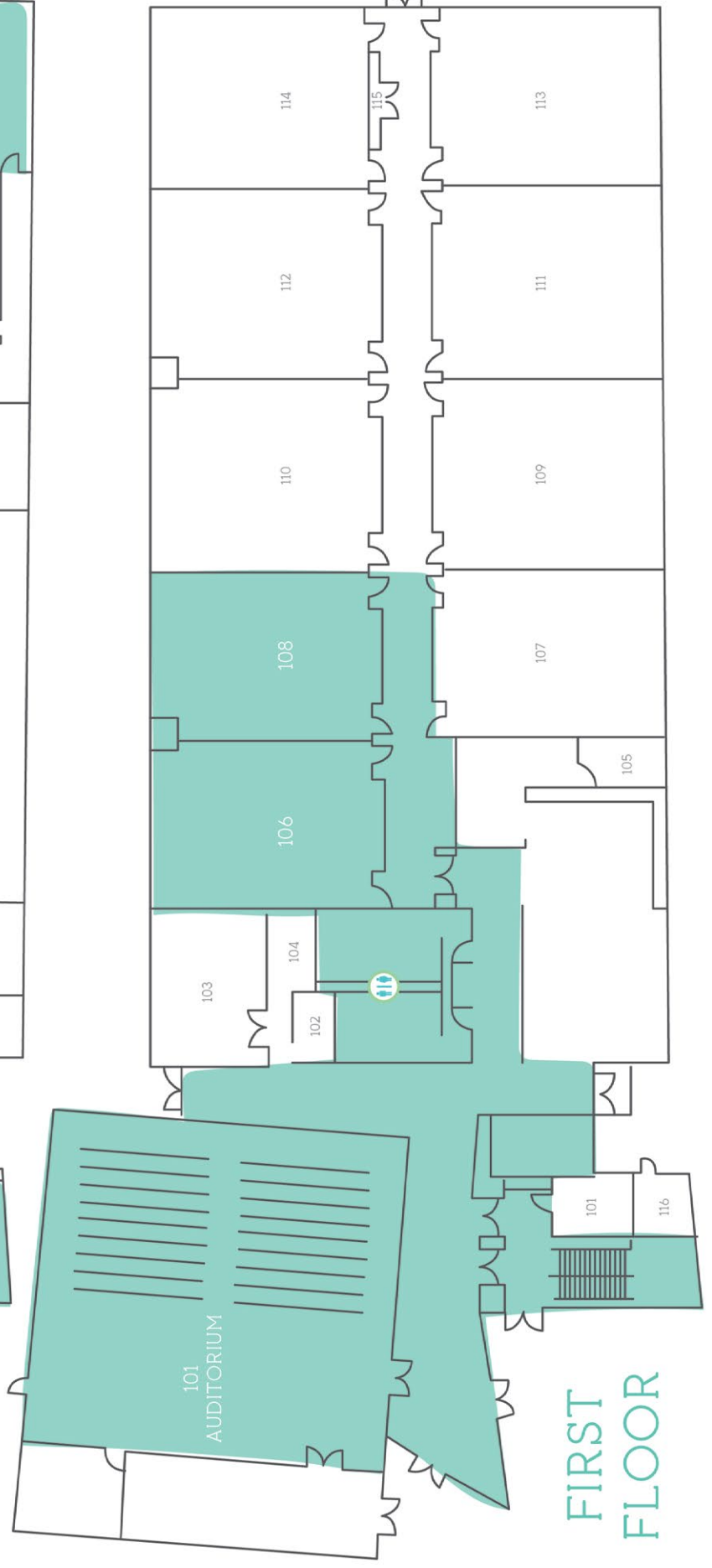
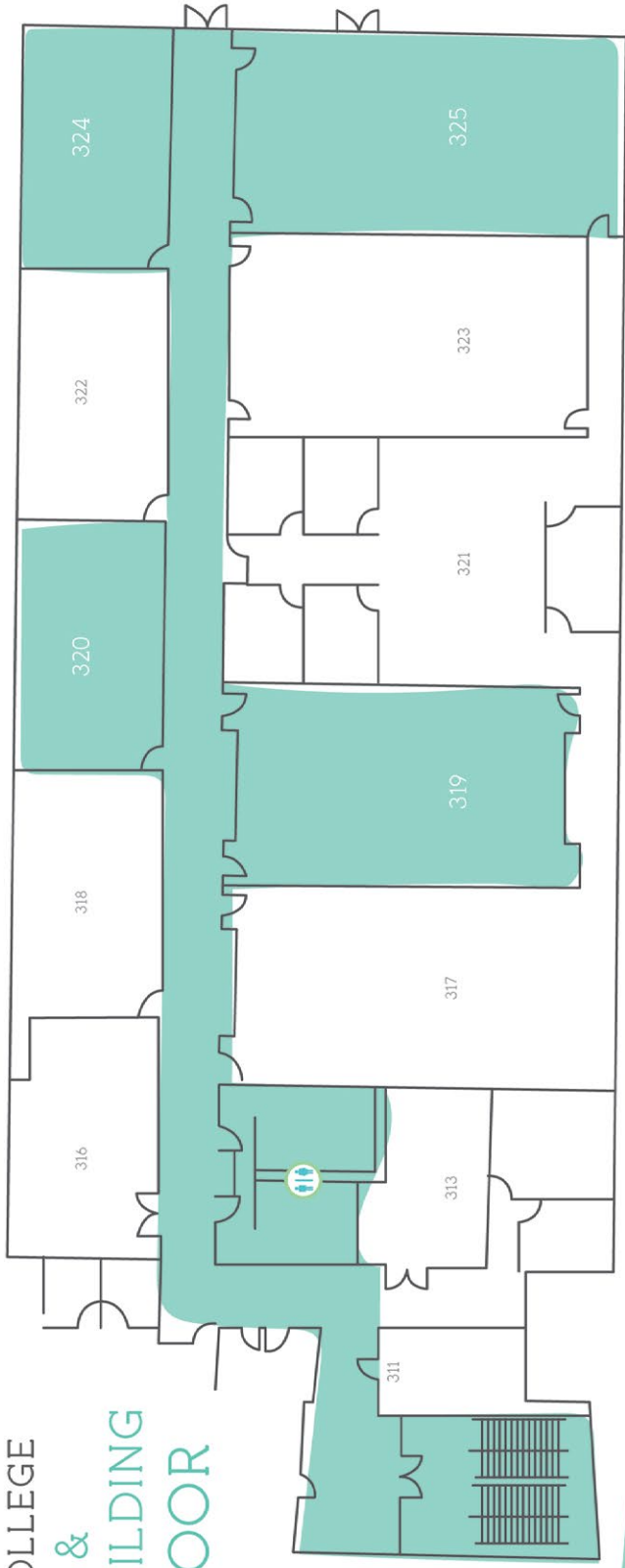
