Description of Credential	The Louisiana Agricultural Education offers twenty different Career Development Events (CDE) for Future Farmers of America (FFA) members to test their skills in all things agriculture. These CDEs reflect content taught in Agriscience classrooms, and students must achieve a high level of proficiency to be successful in their events. The Leadership Development Events (LDE) are structured very similarly to CDEs, but the focus of the events shifts more to leadership development for the student. The benefits received from participating in an LDE include public speaking skills, communication strategies, leadership growth, confidence, memorization skills and teaching strategies.  Emerging:  1.
