	To get certified:								
	1. Pass the Autodesk Professional Certification exam.								
	2. Submit an online application.								
	3. Complete the ACI Teacher Training e-Course with a passing score of 70 points or higher.								
	4. Complete the certification process through an onsite ACI Workshop or be evaluated via video submission online.								
	In both cases, a candidate is assessed on instructional skills and the ability to deliver lessons.								
	To be eligible for the ACI program, a candidate must :								
	1. Pass the current Autodesk Professional Certification exam.								
	2. Have at least one-year experience teaching.								
	3. Clearly understand the content framework in the Industry Standards documents of ACI.
