The exam must be closed book/closed notes and must be proctored by a school instructor/administrator. Any student enrolled in the school and taking the curriculum may take the exam. Accommodations may be made for students with learning or physical disabilities as long as the exam is proctored as listed above. Individuals taking the START program online will be able to access the online exam upon completing the course.
