Instructor Certification Requirements (by certifying agency)	CompTIA A+ teacher certification is required.

Pearson VUE confirms the identity of exam candidates and provides a controlled environment for collecting and transmitting exam results. Students create their own CompTIA Certification account and can track CompTIA A+ certification (and other certifications offered by CompTIA) online.
