Testing Details (including any age requirements / accommodations)	Exam Codes are FC0-U51 and FC0-U61.FC0-U51 retires July 15 2019. ITF FC0-U61 was released in October 2018 and will be valid for three years from that date. Students must pass an exam composed of 75 multiple choice and performance-based questions. Length of test is 60 minutes. Passing score is 650 out of 900. No prior experience necessary. Exams are administered at Pearson Vue Authorized Testing Centers. Schools can become authorized testing centers through CompTIA Academy Partners. Request information: academy@comptia.org. Educators seeking accommodations must email their request to http://pearsonvue.com at least 30 days before testing.

Instructor Certification Requirements (by certifying agency)	CompTIA IT Fundamentals teacher certification required. Instructors may be interested in joining the CompTIA Instructor Network.							
Proctoring / Test Security (if any)	CompTIA exams are administered under secure, proctored conditions at Authorized Pearson VUE testing centers. Pearson VUE confirms the identity of exam candidates and provides a controlled environment for collecting and transmitting exam results. Schools may establish a Pearson VUE testing center on their campus. See https://home.pearsonvue.com/For-test-centers.aspx IT Fundamentals may also be delivered through the CompTIA Anywhere Proctor Test Delivery System . Anywhere Proctor program allows candidates to register and take a standard certification exam wherever there is an approved Anywhere Proctor present and an internet-connected PC that meets system requirements NOTE: high stakes exams such as A+, Network+ and Security+ may NOT be delivered through the Anywhere Proctor program.							
Certification Tracking								
Credentialing Documentation	CompTIA maintains all documentation. Students create their own CompTIA Certification account and can track CompTIA IT Fundamentals certification (and other certifications offered by CompTIA) online. Students can print out copies of the certifications they have earned or have the certifications mailed to them. Teachers can track the certification results of their students using the student voucher number used for the exam. Schools will not be able to track the results of students who take the exam at a public testing center without the cooperation /disclosure by the student. Sample CompTIA certification

If you're purchasing vouchers on behalf of students, learn how a CompTIA IT Fundamentals site license could benefit your school. Order FCO-U51 (retires July 15 2019) or FCO-U61 if your school participates in the CompTIA Anywhere Proctored program or if you plan to have your students take their exams at a Pearson VUE test center. Vouchers expire 12 months after issued.
