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# CLTCC-----Transfer Degree

CLTCC offers general education courses through articulation agreements with LSUA, NSU and UIU

CLTCC general education courses are transferrable to any public Louisiana college or university

# CLTCC----- Transfer Degree

Students pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree are required to take and complete general education courses

Courses are taken early in the program before student's core degree coursework

Provides broad background in all major academic disciplines (math, natural science, social science, humanities and composition)

# CLTCC Dual Enrollment Benefits

- Earn high school credit and apply towards TC, TD or Associate's Degree
- Transition from high school to college more easily
- Lower college expenses by reducing amount of time in college
- Expedite entry into workforce (Earn real money sooner)
- Earn general education credits acceptable at 4 year college/university
