- Portal Usage & Timeliness
- Students Own Account
 - No School Email
 - Keep a log
 - Do not do it for students
- Affiliation/Status
- Licenses
 - Attention to questions
 - License after course completed

Louisiana Believes

Best Practices

- National EMS Education Standards
- FERPA & HIPPA apply for BEMS
- Not a “feel good” license
 - Several students now working
