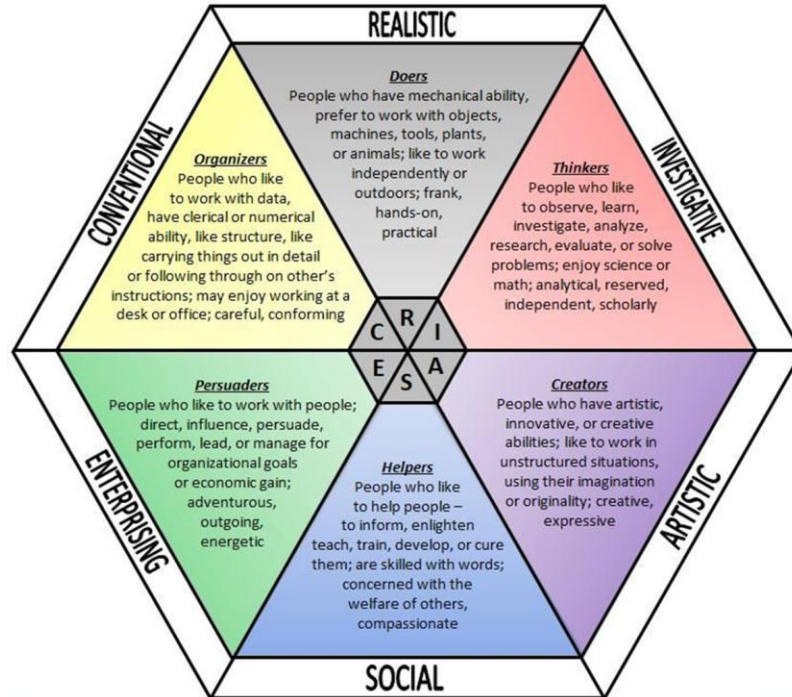

John Holland's Theory

1. 6 **personality types (RIASEC)**
2. People with the **same personality types** work well together and reward behavior that supports that personality type
3. 6 basic **types of work environments**
4. People seek environments that match their **skills and abilities** and express their **values and attitudes**
5. People who work in environments similar to their personality type are **more likely to be successful and satisfied**
6. Your workplace (or school) has an effect on **how you act or work** and on **how comfortable you are** in that environment.

- **Investigative** — Investigative occupations frequently involve working with ideas, and require an extensive amount of thinking. These occupations can involve searching for facts and figuring out problems mentally.
- **Realistic** — Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often deal with plants, animals, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.
- **Social** — Social occupations frequently involve working with, communicating with, and teaching people. These occupations often involve helping or providing service to others.

Radiologists

Also called: Diagnostic Radiologist, Physician, Radiologist, Radiology Resident

What they do:

Examine and diagnose disorders and diseases using x-rays and radioactive materials. May treat patients.

On the job, you would:

- Obtain patients' histories from electronic records, patient interviews, dictated reports, or by communicating with referring clinicians.
- Prepare comprehensive interpretive reports of findings.
- Perform or interpret the outcomes of diagnostic imaging procedures including magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), computer tomography (CT), positron emission tomography (PET), nuclear cardiology treadmill studies, mammography, or ultrasound.

Radiologic Technologists

Also called: Mammographer, Radiologic Technologist (RT), Radiological Technologist, X-Ray Technologist (X-Ray Tech)

What they do:

Take x rays and CAT scans or administer nonradioactive materials into patient's blood stream for diagnostic purposes. Includes technologists who specialize in other scanning modalities.

On the job, you would:

- Review and evaluate developed x-rays, video tape, or computer-generated information to determine if images are satisfactory for diagnostic purposes.
- Operate or oversee operation of radiologic or magnetic imaging equipment to produce images of the body for diagnostic purposes.
- Use radiation safety measures and protection devices to comply with government regulations and to ensure safety of patients and staff.
