Our district offers a Millwrighting class, supported by International Paper. This program aligns with the industry-aligned CITF advanced credential program, offering students a path towards a recognized industry credential.

Support from International Paper

International Paper's commitment to our program goes beyond financial support. Their employees actively collaborate with our instructors, sharing their expertise and real-world knowledge. They also donate equipment for hands-on learning, giving students the opportunity to work with the tools they will use in the field. In addition, they provide paid internships for students aged 17 and older during summer programs, offering them valuable work experience and a chance to learn from industry professionals. International Paper also prioritizes hiring our graduates, creating a clear path for students to transition from the classroom to a successful career.

Logistics


We're working with International

opportunities.




Broadcasting, Internet& Communication
