Jumpstart Level	These credentials signify that an individual has successfully obtained a subset of prerequisite knowledge needed to pursue a postsecondary educational pathway leading to teacher certification in Louisiana. The certificate provides opportunities for entry-level employment as a teacher apprentice in a variety of non-certified educator roles in Louisiana. Basic: 1. IBC# 590 — Louisiana Pre-Educator Credential Complete a full LDOE Jumpstart Pre-Educator Pathway AND, one of the following: • Earn two dual enrollment credits from the required educator pathway course offerings, or • Earn two-micro-credentials Advanced: 2. IBC# 591 — Louisiana Pre-Educator Credential To obtain the Louisiana Pre-Educator Credential — Advanced, a student must: • Complete a full LDOE Jumpstart Pre-Educator Pathway AND, • Earn at least two dual enrollment credits from the required Pre-Educator Pathway course offerings AND, • Passing score on the Qualifying ACT/SAT score equivalent (ACT composite score of 22), OR SAT combined verbal and math score of 1100 or higher (New SAT).
